<p>There is currently a vacancy for a member of St Mary's to become a Foundation Governor on the Governing Body of Linton CE Infant School. The role is to represent the interests of the church in the governance of the school and to support the school's leadership team in ensuring the provision of a high quality education for all pupils, in the context of a strong Christian ethos. This is an interesting role, affording opportunities for developing relationships between St Mary's Church and the Infant School pupils and their families. Governors should have an interest in education, but are not required to have direct experience of working in a school. A knowledge of managing budgets and financial planning would also be helpful, but not necessary.
