We have now been able to purchase a defibrillator, which is to be sited on the outside of the church pavilion. This has been made possible through a generous grant from the Anderson Trust and London Hearts, and fundraising at our February Coffee Morning. Once the defibrillator is installed, it will be registered on the national register www.thecircuit.uk

Training in the use of the defibrillator is not mandatory, because the machine talks you through the process, but we recommend the training to assist understanding and practising CPR (cardio-pulmonary resuscitation). Anne Parry-Smith
