Music lovers are in for a special treat this July when acclaimed pianists Cédric Boyer and Rémi Furlanetto present an evening of four-hand piano music at St Mary's Church, Linton.

The concert will feature a varied and engaging programme of works by Schubert, Moszkowsky, Fauré and Prokofiev. Performing together at a single piano, the duo will showcase the rich textures and virtuosity of the four-hand repertoire. Adding to the occasion is the instrument itself: an Erard piano built in London in 1890. Renowned for their craftsmanship and distinctive sound, Erard pianos were favoured by many of the great composers and performers of the nineteenth century.

Update: Giving makes a difference

In June 2026 our Church received **£4,013.14** from the Parish Giving Scheme which is made up of **52 donations ranging from £1 per month to £410 per month**. The Friends of St Mary's was founded in the 1980s to restore, preserve, repair, maintain and improve Linton's medieval Parish Church building, which is the only Grade I Listed Building in the village. The Friends have recently paid £30,000 towards the cost of two replacement boilers to keep the building warm and are

committed to paying for over £17,000 later in the year for additional heating work and repair work recommended by the Church Architect.
